2023 in review:

Repairs:

- 1. Mainly customer lines and breaks in main lines in Section II
- 2. Deepwell pump for well 5 was pulled and a leak in the riser line repaired
- 3. Due to lightning activity the controller for the standby generator was destroyed, this has been replaced.
- 4. A surge suppressor is now installed in the power system for the pump house and wells 2 and 5
- 5. One pressure pump electric motor replaced
- 6. Maintenance contract for generator was initiated

No volunteer projects planned

Operator:

Minor repairs, 24 hr phone service, meter reading, general plant management

Plans for 2023 and Long Term:

- 1. Continue operating with FloWatch
- 2, Battle infrastructure repairs in Section II
- 3. Make minor repairs to tanks and piping
- 4. Control cost and expenses by early warning of leaks or other abnormalities

- 5. Consideration to replace the client meters over time to remote readable meters to improve reading accuracy and bring reading cost down
- 6. Accumulate capital for Section II infrastructure and increase the dues for the water system with 10%
- 7. Look into option for partly early repairs of infrastructure of Section II
- 8. Small rate increase on base usage and additional amounts due to inflation and cost increase.
- 9. Proposed 10% on base would become \$ 37.41 from \$ 34.31, additional from \$ 5.75 to \$ 6.00 per 500 gallons additional usage
